Mask-making and 3-D Building

June 19-23

Students will first do mask making using medical gauze. If you love 3-D building, start collecting recycled items for the second project because the sky's the limit during this papier-mâché and medical gauze unit! All art can be decorated using acrylics, feathers, beads, buttons, glitter and more.

Pastel, Water Color or Silk Painting

June 12-16

Participants will be introduced to soft pastel, water color or silk-painting techniques. They can select subjects such as landscapes, still life, or portraits that will lead to a successfully completed art work. Techniques, color, line, value, texture and proportion will be emphasized.

Painting or Recycled Jewelry

June 19-23

Participants will learn to build and paint on canvas (provided) or furniture (not included) using a variety of techniques and tools with acrylics or oils. Others may choose creating with recycled jewelry. Resin and other creative techniques will provide unlimited possibilities for jewelry creations. Materials will be provided, but students are encouraged to bring in otherwise discarded jewelry such as broken watches, unmatched earrings, outdated necklaces and bracelets to use in their own creation

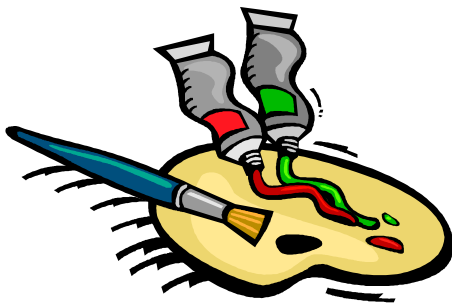
